Bible Study Guide for July 8-14, 2012
Judges 10-12 and 2 Peter 3

Sunday – Read Judges 11 and 2 Peter 3

1. What did you find most profitable in these scriptures? Why?
2. What did you find most profitable in today's sermons? Why?
3. How will you apply what you learned?

Prayer focus: For wisdom to understand God's word and to apply it to your life.

Monday – Read Judges 10

1. Who were the two judges that served Israel between Abimelech and Jephthah?
2. What became of Israel after Jair died?
3. When they cried out to God for help, how did God answer them?
4. How did the people respond to God?
5. How does the ending of this chapter anticipate what will happen with Jephthah?

Prayer focus: To remember the Lord and not turn from his grace.

Tuesday – Read Judges 11

1. What did Jephthah's brothers do to him?
2. Why did the elders go out to bring Jephthah back to be their leader in the fight against the Ammonites?
3. How did Jephthah respond?
4. What vow did Jephthah make to the Lord?
5. How was this vow fulfilled?

Prayer focus: To trust God more without manipulation.

Wednesday – Read Judges 12

1. Why were the Ephraimites upset, and what did they vow to do?
2. How did Jephthah defend himself?
3. What resulted from this conflict?
4. What does the story of Jephthah teach about leadership?
5. What does the story of Jephthah teach about following God?

Prayer focus: For growth in obedience to God.

Thursday – Read 2 Peter 3 (1-7)

1. What is it that Peter wants to remind the believers of?
2. Why?
3. What fact have the scoffers overlooked?
4. What are the heavens and earth being stored up for?
5. What does this passage teach about judgment and repentance?

Prayer focus: To submit yourself to God and his word.

Friday – Read 2 Peter 3 (8-13)

1. What fact does Peter want the believers to not overlook?
2. Why is the Lord delaying his return?
3. Why should we not be complacent about the Lord's return (v. 10)?
4. What sort of people ought we to be as we wait?
5. How can you live a life of holiness and godliness?

Prayer focus: To live in anticipation of the Lord's return.

Saturday – Read Judges 13-16 and 2 Peter 3

1. What are the main themes of these sections of scripture?
2. How do these sections of scripture develop and extend the teaching from the earlier sections you studied this week?
3. How do they help you prepare for Sunday worship?

Prayer focus: To be prepared to hear the word of the Lord on Sunday.
