**Bible Study Guide for September 30-October 6, 2012**  
**Acts 4:23-31 and Joshua 5:13-6:27**

**Sunday – Read Acts 4:23-31 and Joshua 5:13-6:27**

1. What did you find most profitable in these scriptures? Why?
2. What did you find most profitable in today's sermons? Why?
3. How will you apply what you learned?

Prayer focus: For wisdom to understand God's word and to apply it to your life.

**Monday – Read Acts 4:23-31**

1. What was the first thing the church did after hearing Peter and John's report?
2. What was the theme of their prayer?
3. What were the results of their prayer?
4. What did you learn from this prayer that will help you pray more fervently?

Prayer focus: For a boldness in faith to proclaim the gospel.

**Tuesday – Read Acts 4:23-31**

1. How was God addressed in this prayer?
2. How are the first two clauses of this prayer connected to the title God is addressed with?
3. How is the opposition from the religious leaders put into scriptural context?
4. How is the request for boldness put into the same context?

Prayer focus: To have the same desire for boldness to proclaim the word.

**Wednesday – Read Joshua 5:13-6:27 (5:13-15)**

1. What did Joshua see when he was near Jericho?
2. What did Joshua assume the man to be?
3. How did the man introduce himself to Joshua?
4. What instructions did he have for Joshua?
5. What similarities do you see between this story and a similar one involving Moses? (look at Exodus 3)

Prayer focus: For discernment to know and obey God's commands.

### **Thursday – Read Joshua 5:13-6:27 (6:1-14)**

1. What did God tell Joshua about Jericho?
2. How would the Israelites defeat the city?
3. How many days were they to march around the city, and what were they to do as they marched?
4. What lessons does this story teach about obedience to God?

Prayer focus: To be obedient and follow God's plan.

### **Friday – Read Joshua 5:13-6:27 (6:15-27)**

1. What happened on the seventh day?
2. What did Joshua say concerning Rahab?
3. What did he command them to do?
4. What oath did Joshua put on the city?
5. What was the result of this battle for Joshua?

Prayer focus: To know that God's plan is best, no matter how long it takes to be worked out.

### **Saturday – Read Joshua 7**

1. What are the main themes of these sections of scripture?
2. How do these sections of scripture develop and extend the teaching from the earlier sections you studied this week?
3. How do they help you prepare for Sunday worship?

Prayer focus: To be prepared to hear the word of the Lord on Sunday.
