**Hebrews 10:19-39 and Joshua 9**

**Sunday – Read Hebrews 10:19-39 and Joshua 9**

1. What did you find most profitable in these scriptures? Why?
2. What did you find most profitable in today's sermons? Why?
3. How will you apply what you learned?

Prayer focus: For wisdom to understand God's word and to apply it to your life.

**Monday – Read Hebrews 10:19-39 (19-25)**

1. What are the two reasons given for why we should draw near?
2. What three commands ("let us") are given in this passage?
3. How are they connected to each other?
4. The phrase "not neglecting to meet together" is derived from a different command. Which command is it derived from, and how does that phrase fit within this passage?
5. How can meeting more regularly with other Christians help you?

Prayer focus: To recognize what has been accomplished for us through Christ.

**Tuesday – Read Hebrews 10:19-39 (26-31)**

1. What changes for those who go on sinning deliberately after receiving knowledge of the truth?
2. According to verse 29, how is "deliberate seen" seen?
3. How does the Lord view this sin and what will he do about it?
4. Why is it a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God?
5. What does this passage teach you about judgment for deliberate sin?

Prayer focus: To maintain faith and avoid ongoing, deliberate sin.

**Wednesday – Read Hebrews 10:19-39 (32-39)**

1. What had they experienced earlier in their Christian lives?
2. How does the writer use this to encourage them not to throw away their confidence?
3. What is it he says they have need of, and what will be the result of this?
4. According to verse 39, how does the writer encourage them to keep their faith?
5. What in this passage most encourages you to hold strong to your faith?

Prayer focus: For perseverance in faith.

### **Thursday – Read Joshua 9 (1-15)**

1. What was the response of the other kings of the land beyond the Jordan to Israel's success?
2. How did the Gibeonites respond differently?
3. What did they do?
4. How did Joshua respond to them?
5. What does verse 14 imply about how Israel should have responded?
6. How did they respond?

Prayer focus: To trust God completely in all things.

### **Friday – Read Joshua 9 (16-27)**

1. What happened after three days?
2. How did the congregation of Israel feel about this?
3. What answer did the leaders give to the congregation?
4. What did Joshua say to the Gibeonites?
5. How did they answer him?
6. How did things end for the Gibeonites?

Prayer focus: To always be truthful in our words and deeds with others.

### **Saturday – Read Acts 4:32-5:11 and Joshua 10**

1. What are the main themes of these sections of scripture?
2. How do these sections of scripture develop and extend the teaching from the earlier sections you studied this week?
3. How do they help you prepare for Sunday worship?

Prayer focus: To be prepared to hear the word of the Lord on Sunday.
