**Hebrews 5:11-6:12**

**Sunday – Read Hebrews 5:11-6:12**

1. What did you find most profitable in these scriptures? Why?
2. What did you find most profitable in today's sermons? Why?
3. How will you apply what you learned?

Prayer focus: For wisdom to understand God's word and to apply it to your life.

**Monday – Read Hebrews 5:11-6:12 (5:11-14)**

1. What does the writer want to say much more about? Why doesn't he?
2. What problem does he identify that these believers are guilty of?
3. What contrast does he use to discuss their spiritual maturity?

Prayer focus: To grow in understanding of God's word and ways.

**Tuesday – Read Hebrews 5:11-6:12 (6:1-8)**

1. What things does the writer include in "the elementary doctrine of Christ"?
2. What does he highlight as the single biggest problem to maturity?
3. What is the state of those who had once been Christians but have fallen away by rejecting Christ?
4. Why?
5. How does the writer's farming analogy work to explain this idea?

Prayer focus: To hold firm to our faith.

**Wednesday – Read Hebrews 5:11-6:12 (6:9-12)**

1. Does the writer think these Christians have fallen?
2. What does he acknowledge about their present lives that gives him confidence in them?
3. What does he desire for them?
4. Rather than being sluggish, what does he want from them?
5. How do "the promises" serve as an encouragement to persevere?

Prayer focus: To continue steadfast in service to God.

### **Thursday – Read Psalm 30**

1. What is the theme of this psalm?
2. What is the reason to sing praises to the Lord?
3. What is the reason the writer wants mercy and deliverance?

Prayer focus: To trust God completely in all things.

### **Friday – Read Proverbs 10**

1. Who is the writer of these proverbs?
2. What are some of the themes in this chapter?
3. What are your three favorite proverbs from this chapter?
4. Why?

Prayer focus: To grow in wisdom and the fear of the Lord.

### **Saturday – Read Acts 5 and Joshua 11**

1. What are the main themes of these sections of scripture?
2. How do these sections of scripture develop and extend the teaching from the earlier sections you studied this week?
3. How do they help you prepare for Sunday worship?

Prayer focus: To be prepared to hear the word of the Lord on Sunday.
